



PARKING

Current overnight valet rates vary between \$60-75/night (depending on business levels). DEC attendees will receive a \$10 discount applied at check-in and will remain the same throughout the guest's stay. There is no self-parking onsite for the hotel.

The Bluebird Cafe is one of the world's preeminent listening rooms. Located in a small strip mall outside of downtown Nashville, the 90-seat venue is unassuming in appearance but some of the most significant songwriters and artists have performed on their stage including Garth Brooks, Keith Urban, Taylor Swift, Faith Hill and more!
